2022 College League of Legends Season
Mountain West Conference Format

1. Conference Format & Schedule

- 1.1. **Regular Season.** This phase consists of a best-of-three round robin, with each team playing each other team once. Starting side choice will be randomly predetermined such that each team has first side choice in half their games.
- 1.2. **Regular Season Tiebreaker.** In the event that multiple teams are tied in the standings at the conclusion of the Regular Season (as defined as having the same number of matches won), then any teams so tied will have their ties broken by head-to-head record. Any ties that cannot be broken in this fashion will be broken by fastest average win time.
- 1.3. **Conference Playoffs.** This phase consists of a two-round single elimination tournament between the top two teams by Regular Season win record from each division, with the first round played within the division. The winning team will advance to the College Championship.

1.4. Schedule

- 1.4.1. **Default Match Time.** All Conference Regular Season and Conference Playoff matches are scheduled for Wednesday at 6:00pm Pacific Time or Saturday at 3:00pm Pacific Time.

1.4.2. Regular Season

- 1.4.2.1. Round 1: Jan 17 - Jan 23
- 1.4.2.2. Round 2-3: Jan 2 - Jan 30
- 1.4.2.3. Round 4-5: Jan 31 - Feb 6
- 1.4.2.4. Round 6: Feb 7 - Feb 13
- 1.4.2.5. Round 7-8: Feb 14 - Feb 20
- 1.4.2.6. Round 9-10: Feb 21 - Feb 27
- 1.4.2.7. Round 11: Feb 28 - Mar 6

1.4.3. Conference Playoffs

- 1.4.3.1. Semifinals: Mar 7 - Mar 13
- 1.4.3.2. Finals: Mar 14 - Mar 20

- 1.4.4. **Changes to Schedule.** College Season officials may, at their sole discretion, re-order the schedule of matches within a given day and/or change the date of a College Season match to a different date or otherwise modify the schedule of matches. In the event that the match schedule is modified, officials will notify all teams at the earliest

convenience.

2. Season Rule Amendments

The rules listed below are amendments to rules listed in the College LoL Season Official Rules that are unique to the Mountain West Conference.

- 2.1. **Academic Status.** To be eligible to represent an institution in intercollegiate athletics competition, a student-athlete shall be enrolled in at least a minimum full-time program of studies, be in good academic standing and maintain progress toward a baccalaureate or equivalent degree.
- 2.2. **Good Academic Standing.** To be eligible to represent an institution in intercollegiate athletics competition, a student-athlete shall be in good academic standing as determined by the academic authorities who determine the meaning of such phrases for all students of the institution, subject to controlling legislation of the conference(s) or similar association of which the institution is a member. The standard of good academic standing required for a student-athlete to represent an institution in intercollegiate athletics competition must be at least as demanding as the institutional standard applied to all students to participate in extracurricular activities.
- 2.3. **Final Semester/Quarter.** A student-athlete may compete while enrolled in less than a minimum full-time program of studies, provided the student is enrolled in the final semester or quarter of the baccalaureate or graduate degree program and the institution certifies that the student is carrying (for credit) the courses necessary to complete degree requirements. Thereafter, the student shall forfeit eligibility in all sports, unless the student completes all degree requirements during that semester or quarter and is eligible to receive the baccalaureate diploma on the institution's next degree-granting date.
